**STANDING ORDER REQUIRING FILING OF
WARRANTS WITH CLERK OF COURT**


WHEREAS, it is necessary for tracking of all criminal cases that warrants be filed with the Clerk of Court in a timely manner;

WHEREFORE, it is now hereby ORDERED AND DECREED, effective immediately, that all law enforcement officers within the Ogeechee Judicial Circuit shall file warrants with the Clerk of Court in the appropriate county within (5) five days of the date the warrant is served; at which time, the Clerk of Court shall give the warrant a case number and judge assignment according to the random case assignment system. If applicable, the Georgia Crime Information Center OBTS form shall also be filed with the Clerk at that time. Thereafter, the Clerk of the Court shall keep a copy and transmit the original warrant and all other papers to the District Attorney's office, pursuant to O.C.G.A. § 17-7-32.


