EXECUTION OF PROBATION WARRANTS

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that after an individual is arrested pursuant to an arrest warrant for a violation of probation, the Probation Office shall notify, in writing, the office of the judge assigned to the case within forty-eight (48) hours after execution of the warrant in order to ensure that all probation revocation matters are timely brought before the Court for a final resolution.

Notification on cases in which the Honorable John R. Turner, Judge, presided shall be given to both Chief Judge William E. Woodrum, Jr. and Judge F. Gates Peed until December 31, 2017.

It is further ordered that the Probation Office shall turn over within five (5) days from the date of this order a list of all probationers currently being held pursuant to a warrant for a violation of probation.
