
**STANDING ORDER REGARDING SUPERVISION OF FELONY PROBATIONERS**


The Superior Courts of the Ogeechee Judicial Circuit, Georgia presume that all defendants convicted of any felony who receive a straight probation or split-sentence which includes community service hours shall be completed by the defendant prior to the expiration of the sentence.


**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that all defendants whose probationary portion includes community service hours shall have the maximum three (3) year time frame as defined by O.C.G.A. § 42-3-52 extended until completion of said community service hours.
