


STANDING ORDER REGARDING SUPERVISION OF FELONY PROBATIONERS


The Superior Courts of the Ogeechee Judicial Circuit, Georgia presume that all defendants convicted of any felony who receive a straight probation or split-sentence which includes community service hours shall be completed by the defendant prior to the expiration of the sentence.


IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that all defendants whose probationary portion includes community service hours shall have the maximum three (3) year time frame as defined by O.C.G.A. § 42-3-52 extended until completion of said community service hours.
