IN THE SUPERIOR COURT OF EFFINGHAM COUNTY STATE OF GEORGIA

STANDING ORDER REGARDING SUPERVISION OF FELONY PROBATIONERS

The Superior Courts of the Ogeechee Judicial Circuit, Georgia presume that supervised probation of all defendants will continue until all fines, fees, surcharges and restitution are paid in full, and they shall not be subject to the two year supervision limit as specified in O.C.G.A § 17-10-1 (a)(2).

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that all defendants convicted of any felony offense who receive a straight probation or split-sentence will remain on active, supervised probation until they have completed at least 2 years of probation and all fines, fees, surcharges and restitution have been paid in full. These defendants are not to be placed on unsupervised probation until both circumstances are met and/or ordered in writing by the sentencing Superior Court Judge.
